
The Vision.

- Comply with international labor laws and workplace standards.

Duration.

The compulsory internship period is 10, 12 or 20 weeks.



The University must waive students' bench fees (if applicable).


Appoint a supervisor to mentor the students during the internship




Financial Assistance for Students


